



## **8. Содержание дисциплины, структурированное по темам**

Семестр 3

Тема 1. Are you? Can you? Do you? Did you? – Exchanging information

Word order in questions. Common verb phrases. Exchanging information. Understanding personal information.

Тема 2. The perfect date: describing a person

Present Simple. Describing people (appearance and personality). Understanding a description. Pronunciation revision: English sounds. Final –s and –es. Writing: creating a profile.

Тема 3. The remake project: describing a picture, talking about preferences

Present Continuous. Clothes. Prepositions of place. Pronunciation revision: English sounds. Calling reception. Writing a formal and an informal email.

Тема 4. Where's my passport? – Talking about your last holiday

Past Simple: regular and irregular verbs. Holidays. Talking about your last holiday. Understanding the key events in a story. Checking hypotheses. Pronunciation revision: regular verbs: –ed endings.

Тема 5. That's me in the picture

Past Continuous. Prepositions of time and place (at, in, on). Talking about preferences. Listening for gist and detailed information. Checking hypotheses using visual evidence. Pronunciation revision. Weak forms: was, were.

Тема 6. One dark October evening... – Retelling a story

Time sequences and Connectors. Verb phrases. Retelling a story. Listening for specific information. Pronunciation revision: word stress.

Тема 7. A Trip Aside: planning a tour

Be going to (plans and predictions). Planning a tour. Airports. Listening for specific information. Pronunciation revision: the letter g.

Тема 8. Put it in your calendar: making arrangements

Present Continuous (future arrangements). Verb + Preposition. Understanding times, dates and appointments. Making appointments. Understanding a questionnaire. Pronunciation revision: Linking. Writing an email: making plans and arranging meetings.

Тема 9. Word games: describing and paraphrasing

Defining relative clauses. Paraphrasing. Describing. At the restaurant. Pronunciation revision: silent e.

Семестр 4

Тема 10. Who does what: housework

Present Perfect + yet, just, already. Housework, the use of make and do. Talking about housework. Understanding opinions. Pronunciation revision: the letters y and j.

Тема 11. In your basket: shopping

Present Perfect or Past Simple (1). Shopping. Talking about shopping experiences. Understanding a theory. Pronunciation revision: c and ch.

Тема 12. #greatweekeng: communicating online

Something, anything, nothing, etc. Adjective ending –ed and –ing. Pronunciation revision: sound clusters. Your weekend. Understanding historical information, correcting and checking information. Writing: describing your weekend.

Тема 13. Habits and lifestyle

Comparative Adjectives and Adverbs, as... as. Types of numbers. Pronunciation revision. Identifying key points. Scanning for facts and numbers.

Тема 14. A town and a city

Superlatives (+ ever + Present Perfect). Describing a town or city. Talking about memorable experiences. Understanding ranking. Pronunciation revision: sentence stress. Taking something back to a shop.

Тема 15. Health and the body

Quantifiers, too, (not) enough. Health and the body. Advice. Identifying pros and cons. Pronunciation revision.

Тема 16. Positive and negative thinking: the use of opposites

Will / won't (predictions). Opposite verbs. Pronunciation revision: 'll, won't.

Тема 17. "I'll always love you"

Will / won't / shall (other uses). Verb + back. Feelings. Giving examples and reasons. Understanding specific details. Making predictions. Using the existing knowledge to predict content. Understanding the order of events. Pronunciation revision: Word stress: two-syllable verbs.

Тема 18. The meaning of dreaming: talking about past, present, and future

Review of verb forms: present, past, and future. Modifiers. Checking hypotheses, understanding specific information. Making predictions. Summarizing the main point of a text. Writing a summary. Pronunciation revision.

## **9. Текущий контроль по дисциплине**

Текущий контроль по дисциплине проводится путем контроля посещаемости, проведения контрольных работ, тестов по изученному материалу, коммуникативных игр по темам, выполнения домашних заданий, написания письменных работ. Текущий контроль фиксируется в форме контрольной точки не менее одного раза в семестр.

## **10. Порядок проведения и критерии оценивания промежуточной аттестации**

Зачет в третьем семестре и зачет с оценкой в четвертом семестре проводятся в форме заданий на проверку умений и навыков в устной и письменной речи на английском языке и имеют следующую структуру:

Структура зачета с оценкой:

1. Лексико-грамматический тест, включающий вопросы закрытого типа.
2. Задание по аудированию с вопросами закрытого типа.

3. Задание по чтению с вопросами закрытого типа.
4. Задание по письменной речи (напишите письмо в рамках заданной ситуации).
5. Задание по устной речи (представление монологического высказывания с опорой на вербальную ситуацию и/или картинку)

Лексико-грамматический тест, задания по аудированию и чтению содержат вопросы с выбором правильного варианта, задания по письменной и устной речи содержат задания открытого типа. Указанные виды заданий проверяют ИУК-4.2.

The best shopping cities
