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# 1. Компетенции и индикаторы их достижения, проверяемые данными оценочными материалами

#### 2. Оценочные материалы текущего контроля и критерии оценивания

#### Контрольная работа

Обязательные *контрольные работы* проводятся после завершения изучения темы. Контрольные работы могут включать задания различного типа, как стандартизированные, так и творческие.

Критерии оценки результатов выполнения контрольной работы. Каждому заданию присваивается определенное количество баллов. Максимальное количество баллов, которые студент может получить за контрольную работу, соответствует  $100\,\%$ .

Оценка «зачтено» выставляется, если студент дал не менее 65% правильных ответов.

Оценка контрольной работы по пятибалльной шкале.

Оценка «отлично» - 80-100% правильных ответов Оценка «хорошо» - 70-79% правильных ответов Оценка «удовлетворительно» - 60-69% правильных ответов Оценка «неудовлетворительно» - менее 60% правильных ответов

Итоговая оценка вычисляется как среднее арифметическое.

#### Эссе

Небольшая по объему самостоятельная письменная работа на предложенную тему. Цель эссе состоит в развитии навыков самостоятельного творческого мышления и письменного изложения собственных умозаключений. Эссе должно содержать чёткое изложение сути поставленной проблемы, включать самостоятельно проведенный анализ этой проблемы с использованием концепций и аналитического инструментария, выводы, обобщающие авторскую позицию по поставленной проблеме.

Рекомендуемый объем эссе от 250 до 500 слов. Время на написание эссе может быть ограничено (40 мин., аудиторная работа) и неограниченно (домашняя работа).

#### Define the functional stile, its features, and the aim of the texts.

1. A snowfall consists of myriads of minute ice crystals that fall to the ground in the form of frozen precipitation. The formation of snow begins with these ice crystals in the subfreezing strata of the middle and upper atmosphere when there is an adequate supply of moisture present. At the core of every ice crystal is a minuscule nucleus, a solid particle of matter around which moisture condenses and freezes. Liquid water 4 droplets floating in the supercooled atmosphere and free ice crystals cannot coexist within the same cloud, since the vapor pressure of ice is less than that of water. This enables the ice crystals to rob the liquid droplets of their moisture and grow continuously. The process can be very rapid, quickly creating sizable ice crystals, some of which adhere to each other to create a cluster of ice crystals or a snowflake. Simple flakes possess a variety of beautiful forms, usually hexagonal, though the symmetrical shapes reproduced in most microscope photography of snowflakes are not usually found in actual snowfalls. Typically, snowflakes in actual snowfalls consist of broken fragments and clusters of adhering ice crystals.

# From Laws of War: General Orders No. 100 INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF ARMIES OF THE UNITED STATES

IN THE FIELD

Prepared by Francis Lieber, promulgated by President Lincoln, 24 April 1863.

SECTION III

Deserters - Prisoners of war - Hostages - Booty on the battle-field.

Art. 48. Deserters from the American Army, having entered the service of the enemy, suffer death if they fall again into the hands of the United States, whether by capture, or being delivered up to the American Army; and if a deserter from the enemy, having taken service in the Army of the United States, is captured by the enemy, and punished by them with death.

#### 3. Women's Liberation

Since the middle of the century, women around the world have been seeking greater independence and recognition. No longer content with their traditional roles as housewives and mothers, women have joined together to create the women's liberation movement. While the forces behind the international movement vary from culture to culture and from individual to individual, the basic causes in the United States can be traced to three events: the development of

effective birth control methods, the invention of labor-saving devices for the home, and the advent of World War II.

#### 4. From The Hitch Hiker's Guide to the Galaxy By Douglas Adams

Far out in the uncharted backwaters of the unfashionable end of the western spiral arm of the Galaxy lies a small unregarded yellow sun. Orbiting this at a distance of roughly ninety-two million miles is an utterly insignificant little blue green planet whose ape-descended life forms are so amazingly primitive that they still think digital watches are a pretty neat idea. This planet has – or rather had – a problem, which was this: most of the people on it were unhappy for pretty much of the time. Many solutions were suggested for this problem, but most of these were largely concerned with the movements of small green pieces of paper, which is odd because on the whole it wasn't the small green pieces of paper that were unhappy.

- 2. The Style of Official Documents. Features: compositional patterns, stereotyped form. The documents use set expressions inherited from early Victorian period. This vocabulary is conservative. Documents contain a large proportion of formal and archaic words used in their dictionary meaning. In diplomatic and legal documents many words have Latin and French origin. There are a lot of abbreviations and conventional symbols. Function: to reach agreement between two contracting parties; to state the conditions binding two parties in an understanding.
- 3. The Pubicistic Style. Features: a logically precise clear cut syntax; a carefully and thoroughly thought out selection of words; the use of sd and em; carefull paragraphing; intonation full of conviction and persistence; consiseness. Function: to form public opinion, to convince the reader or the listener.
- 4. The Belles-Lettres Style. Features: genuine imaginative means and SDs; the use of words in its contextual meaning; the individual choice of vocabulary which reflects the author's personal evaluation; a peculiar individual selection of syntax; the introduction of elements of other styles; Function: to inform the reader and to impress the reader aesthetically.
- 5. The Newspaper FS brief news items. Features: It states only facts without giving comments. The vocabulary used is neutral and common literary. Specific vocabulary features are: special political and economic terms, non-term political vocabulary, newspaper clichés, abbreviations, neologisms. Function is to inform the reader.
